Green Hudson Restaurant Survey Results Report - Sept. 30, 2023

The Plastic Reduction Committee of Green Hudson recently completed a survey of 44 restaurants in Hudson. We mostly excluded restaurants that were major chains with a few exceptions. The purpose of the survey was to determine how many restaurants are still using polystyrene (Styrofoam) containers as well as other single use products such as straws, utensils, and non-recyclable black plastic. Here are the results of our survey. (Full results available on request).

Number of restaurants that automatically give out straws in house: 17

Number of restaurants had a straw dispenser for customers to take as needed and did not routinely ask or supple straws: 20

Spill stoppers

Restaurants with bars that serve mixed drinks do give out plastic stirrers.
